An Entrancing Panorama

The view from nearly every portion of Faircaks is indescribably boautiful. For hundreds of miles easterly, towering above the foothills—which themselves would be deemed real mountains otherwhere—one sees the magnifect panorams of glistening, snow-capped Sierras, seeming to carry the very universe on their lotty and hoary heads. To the southwest tooms darkly the mighty form of Joaquin Valley; while every evening the sun sets in spienise labeled the heatiful Cocci Manga, plainly visible—one inlety miles to the Westward. Occasionally Mount Shatta, as the extreme head of the Sacramento Valley, and even South, may be discerned.

The nearer view is also entrancing at all times. Fairoaks' Water Supply

Every ranch in Faironks is piped for both irrigation and domestic supply, under high pressure; water being diverted, high up among the mountains, from the head reaches of the American River, and distributed to the high points, to serve as needed in the orchards. Faironks owns its own water distributing system, and steps are being taken to purchase and control the North Fork Ditch from which the water supply for this entire district is taken.

A nne grammar sensor and a fully accredited to the great universities; a good Public Li-brary; a thriving Protestant Fed-erated Church, with a minister of the first rank; a newly organized Catholic Church; the Woman's Thursday Club of 175 members, which ranks high among the best clubs of the State, owning its own building, which is the social center of the community; besides a Farm Bureau Center and a Modern Woodmen Camp-all combine to supply the needs of the community in their respective lines. Running water, electric lights and telephones add city comforts to the delights of rural life. The free services of the Sacramento County Farm Adviser are also at your call.

Various Business Activities

Several modern packing houses handle the citrus and deciduous fruits, olives and almonds, which are the chief products of the colony. A number of mercantile houses and two public garages supply the daily household and ranch needs of the public, with the City of Sacramento only 45 minutes distant by automobile, for the larger or more discriminating needs of the ranchers. A well managed Bank and a Post Office, with both local and rural delivery, and a public telephone station and an electric light and power company, also a local newspaper, play their part in making the circle complete.

Travel and Shipping Facilities

Fairoaks is connected by three paved highways with Sacramento, a growing city of 70,000 population, the Capital of the State, the seat of the California State Fair, and the most important fruit and produce shipping

eenter of the West. These highways make Pairoaks virtually a suburb of Sacramento. A Motor Stage makes regular trips to and from the city, and most of the local freight is transported by motor truck. From Sacramento, both the Southern Pacific and Western Pacific systems connect with San Francisco and the East, and a vest amount of trieight between Sacramento and the Bay is transported by steamers on the river.

The Southern Pacific has a station at Fairoaks, and the Western Pacific is also planning to build an electric feeder into Fairoaks in the near future, as an extension of its Northern Electric system recently acquired, to tap the rich and growing volume of fruits and other products of this part of the Valley.

Important Points

While all settlers are equally welcome to Fairoaks, whether rich or poor—for the community is wholesomely democratic—we are constrained to offer a word of caution, to offset some of the claims put forth by too many unthe curse of California, for often they have made exaggerated and absurd statements, leading the uninformed to believe that all that is necessary to succeed is to purchase a small tract of land, regardless of location or quality of brawn or brain, the possession of the land would make them rich.

While it is always advisable, if possible, to reside on and at least oversee the cultivation of your own ranch, should it be impossible to occupy it immediately, it can be leased, or the necessary labor hired to keep it in a going condition until you are ready to come.

Suggestions to Purchasers

If you are desirous of making your investment count for the most possible, and are not in financial shape to buy and pay for an improved ranch, I offer the following suggestions:

Good vacant tracts, both cleared, ready to plant, or wholly or partly covered with oak timber, can be purchased in Fairoaks and vicinity at from \$135 to \$300 per acre, according to soil, location, and terms of sale. Usually the wooded tracts contain sufficient timber to more than pay for clearing.

With your home garden, chickens and berry patch, if there is strength and a will to do, a comparatively small investment will take care of a growing family while waiting for the vines and trees to mature. Usually it is easy to get work at fair wages throughout a good part of the year, while getting started.

Hints on Planting

A few practical hints may be of service, if you con-

template planting such a vineyard as suggested.

Practically all varieties of grapes thrive in Fairoaks, and it will be well to plant a few of several kinds, such as Musaci, Malaga, Emperor, Cornichon, Conocord, etc. But for standard market varieties it is advisable to plant Thompson's Seedless and Tokay. Both are in strong and growing demand as table grapes, while the Thompson's Seedless has become the most popular raising rape in the country. They are easily dried in the sun, and are then year round. The Muscat is also extensively used for raisins, but more generally in the hotter Fresno district of the San Joaquin Valley.

The best practice here is to plant the rooted slips during the late winter or early spring, in rows of 10x1) feet, or about 450 to the acre. The cost is comparatively small; about five cents each, and the cost of digging, planting and staking about five cents more per vine. Of

course this can be reduced materially if you do part of the work your self. The grapes, with proper care, should begin profitable bearing by the third year.

Where all labor is hired, the cost of plowing, cultivating, irrigating and pruning will average about \$25 per acre per year.

Interplanting is frequently practiced with grapes; the larger types of rult or nut trees being planted at intervals of 20 to 50 feet (as in the case of wahnuts), permitting the more quickly maturing grapes to come into bearing and for several years to produce profitable crops before the larger and more slowly maturing trees demand the ground to themselves.
